

What is Frontline Training Center (FTC)?

Frontline Ministries International (FMI) launched Frontline Training Center (FTC) in 2004 as a way to train, equip and commission lovers of the Lord whose passion is to bring His Kingdom into every sphere of cultural influence. FTC offers courses that not only teach the truths of Kingdom living, they also position students to experience those truths in transformative ways. Through Spirit-led teaching, the laying on of hands (impartation), prophetic prayer, and practical application, FTC helps its participants grow into the fullness all that God has for them.

FTC graduates occupy positions of leadership throughout the world. They work as accountants and doctors, they run businesses and law firms, they paint and write, they teach and preach. FTC has taught them that wherever they are stationed they are to walk in alignment with the Father's heart, to minister the Spirit's freedom to those in bondage, and to manifest the loving presence of God to all.

Can you give me an overview of FTC?

Participation in FTC is composed of four main elements:

- integration into the life, vision and mission of FMI and the Frontline Worship Center
- participation in your School's courses, workshops and impartation/activation experiences
- mentoring by the FMI pastors and FTC leaders for purposes of spiritual healing and growth
- participation in safe, supervised ministry, outreach and leadership opportunities

FTC is organized into four training Schools. Each School has its own set of courses and experiences. The four Schools along with their primary areas of specialization are as follows:

- ***School of Worship***
 - trains and equips worship team members and leaders to honor the Father through the prophetic release of His presence and healing power in worship
- ***School of Supernatural Ministry***
 - trains and equips those seeking to honor the Father through anointed ministries of prophecy, healing, deliverance, intercession and evangelism
- ***School of Business and the Marketplace***
 - trains and equips those seeking to honor the Father through the release of supernatural wisdom and creativity within various spheres of influence in the marketplace
- ***School of Media and the Creative Arts***
 - trains and equips those seeking to honor the Father through the release of supernatural wisdom and creativity in various forms of media and the creative arts

In addition to courses within each school there are several foundational courses that each FTC participant in all four Schools must take. These courses can be taken before, after or concurrent with other courses within your School of choice. These courses include the following:

- Genesis Class: an introduction to FMI and its values and vision
- Exodus Class: an introduction to key principles of Kingdom Living
- School of Extreme Prophetic: an introduction to street evangelism

- Prophetic Boot Camp: an introduction to prophetic ministry
- Glory School: an introduction to experiencing the presence of the Lord
- Freedom Class: an experiential class focusing on spiritual breakthrough

Each School participant is free to take courses in the other Schools of FTC so long as the core requirements of his or her School of choice are being met. It is also possible for FTC participants to take courses from any of the four Schools without declaring a School of choice.

What makes FTC's training unique?

FTC's uniqueness is found in its primary core value: *honor*! FTC exists, first and foremost, to honor the Father's loving, healing presence within and among us. Through FTC's Spirit-given curriculum and practical experiences, believers learn how to steward that presence in the world.

FTC is unique in the way it educates the whole person. Every area of human living -- the physical, the emotional, as well as the spiritual -- is mentored into alignment with the loving heart of the Father. All this takes place within a safe, supportive, loving environment. We encourage stepping out in faith, even at the risk of making mistakes. While FTC teaches that the finished work of the Cross is indeed complete, the actualizing of that work in the life of the believer is a process. FTC honors that process by exercising the fruits of gentleness, patience, and loving-kindness in all its practices.

FTC is unique in its focus on the Romans 12 mandate to be "transformed by the renewing of your mind". FTC's training is not primarily about transmitting knowledge and experience, as important as those are. It is about effecting transformation from within, a complete and radical change in worldview, so that we may live "from the inside out". We know that the enemy is out to steal, kill, and destroy this generation for he knows his time is short. But it will be the "presence seekers" who, with renewed minds, can see what Father-God is up to, whom the Father chooses and equips to co-labor with Him in His works of deliverance and restoration.

And FTC is unique in its emphasis on "receiving, not striving". FTC's training is delightfully free of religious overtones. Instead, it aims to give free reign to the Spirit's loving influence. We know that the fruits and gifts of the Spirit can only become manifest as we cease trying to produce them on our own. With FTC's emphasis on resting, soaking, waiting, watching, fasting and other time-tested disciplines, we aim to cultivate a people wholly ready to "believe and receive" all that the Lord has for us in this season.

What kind of results have you seen from FTC training?

The FTC curriculum is designed to train and equip each participant to live out his or her divinely appointed destiny -- all in a safe, family-like setting undergirded at all points by the Father's loving presence. The results of FTC training have been nothing short of supernatural. Testimonies from our students pour in daily. These include:

- instantaneous healings in the aisles of Wal-Mart
- debts disappear as personal finances are prayed over
- businesses grow through divinely revealed strategies
- songs are written that stir the body to higher levels of worship

- demon-possessed children weep for joy after being delivered
- homeless are escorted to the altar as they give their lives to Jesus
- conflicts at work resolve themselves supernaturally
- rebellious family members come back to the Lord
- divine favor manifests in the arenas of sales, law, medicine and accounting
- signs and wonders appear (e.g., gold dust, gemstones) in homes, schools and at work

We invite you to join us at FTC for a passionate partnership in pursuit of His Presence. If there ever was a time to get serious and go after all the Lord has revealed, it's now. May you enjoy all that Jesus died and rose to purchase for you, His bride!

We take new registrations all year round. Most courses are offered during Fall, Winter and Spring terms. Summers are reserved for mission trips, independent study and other forms of outreach experiences. New FTC participants will meet with the FTC Director, and/or the Overseer of his or her School of choice, to determine together the best schedule for them. While regular attendance is expected, we will work with participants around scheduling conflicts. Most FTC participants attend courses on a part-time basis (one or two courses at a time). The FTC program is flexible enough to allow for even the busiest of people to participate!

Besides courses, what other opportunities are there?

In addition to course attendance, we also encourage FTC participants to further their training by attending one or more of the following corporate gatherings.

- *Lighthouses*: these are mid-week gatherings for corporate worship, intercession, bible study and impartation
- *Fire and Wind*: this is a our Tuesday night meeting for corporate worship and Spirit-led revelation which usually includes hands-on ministry and prophetic impartation
- *Watch of the Lord*: this takes place monthly (depending on missions schedule) and is a focused time of "through the night" prayer and fasting along the lines of Isaiah 62

- *Soaking*: the FMI Soaking Center is open to all FTC participants and meets weekly for two hours of prayer, rest and meditative worship
- *Mission Trips*: as the Lord leads, FTC participants are encouraged to join us on our trips abroad to bring the love and healing power of Christ to the nations
- *Outreach*: on a bi-monthly basis we visit local nursing homes, a mental hospital, homeless shelters and downtown streets to bring the love of Jesus to people in need

What kind of supervision will I receive?

As the Lord designed us to live in freedom, a proper understanding of spiritual parenting and sonship is essential. We desire to properly assist each participant in his/her spiritual journey through this divinely appointed provision as together we hold fast to the Biblical mandate for Godly, loving submission, which in turn breeds true honor, purity, and integrity in the individual. We therefore encourage each FTC participant to regularly examine where he/she stands in the area of humility before God and man, and of willingness to receive Godly counsel and impartation from those God has placed over them.

Proper assessment of what the Lord is doing/saying in one's life throughout the FTC experience is essential for the healthy spiritual growth of the individual, as well as for FMI as a corporate body. Each participant will therefore have numerous opportunities for open discussion and review of spiritual progress with members of the FTC leadership team. We desire to partner with you as you journey into deeper wholeness so you can know in every area of your life that you are free from all bondage, as promised in John 8:32: "And you will know the truth and the truth will make you free."

How does the instruction work at FTC?

Participants in the school are trained and equipped for to live out their Kingdom mandates through Spirit-empowered impartation, anointed teaching, and practical activation experiences as facilitated and supervised by anointed ministers from within the FMI body. We also have a growing number of adjunct instructors that visit Frontline from time to time and who offer workshops for FTC participants. Courses meet for instruction on a weekly, biweekly, or monthly basis depending on the course content and the schedules of the participants and leader(s). Most meetings will take place at Frontline Worship Center in one of our conference rooms, but some may meet in nearby homes or other venues appropriate to instruction. It is possible for FTC participants to take more than one course at a time. Most courses will require some outside work or "homework" of one sort or another.

What else should I know about FTC?

Housing for FTC participants is not currently provided. FTC will, however, make every effort to help a new participant find appropriate accommodations when new to the area. Each full-time participant is encouraged to find part-time employment to provide for all living expenses (food, shelter, and clothing). While FTC participants may engage in supervised internships of various sorts, these are normally non-paid positions.

Currently, junior high students and younger will receive training through Frontline Worship Center's Kingdom Kids program. High school-age students can participate in FTC with parental/guardian consent and FTC leadership approval. FTC participation sees itself as preparing a multi-generational end-times army who are trained and experienced in the basics of radical, warrior living.

There currently are no tuition fees for participation in FTC beyond the non-refundable registration fee. Costs for participation in FTC courses are limited to the purchase price of any required course materials such as workbooks, CD's, DVD's, etc. Many FTC courses do not have any costs at all.
