

# ***I BELIEVE...***

As a participant in Frontline Training Center (FTC), and with the Holy Spirit's help, I agree to live in alignment with with the core beliefs and values of Frontline Ministries International and its Frontline Training Center. These include the following:

## **FMI and FTC BELIEFS**

- **I believe** in one eternal God, Creator of the universe and Redeemer of all, perfect in holiness, justice and love, who is revealed in three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (I John 5: 6-8; II Cor. 13: 14; John 3: 16, 17; Matthew 3: 16, 17).
- **I believe** the Bible to be the Holy Spirit-inspired and only infallible and authoritative Word of God (II Timothy 3: 16; Matthew 3: 16, 17; II Peter 1: 19-21; Hebrews 4: 12; I Peter 1: 23-25).
- **I believe** that Jesus Christ is God's Son in the flesh. He was conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin, Mary, performed many might works, and died on the cross in atonement for my sins and to free us from the power of the enemy. He rose from the dead on the third day and ascended into heaven where He sits on the right hand of the Father interceding for us (John 10: 30, 58; John 20: 24-29; Mt. 1: 22; Luke 24: 39-43; Romans 5: 8; John 14: 2, 3; Romans 8: 34; I Cor. 15: 3-6; I Tim. 3: 16; Acts 1: 10, 11).
- **I believe** that Jesus Christ indwells believers through the Holy Spirit so that we may bring His reign to the ends of the earth and prepare for His triumphant and imminent return (John 14:23-29; John 15:5; 1 Cor. 3:16; I Thessalonians 4: 13-18; Matt. 16:7; Acts 3:19-21; 2 Tim. 4:1-2; 1 John 2:27).
- **I believe** that eternal salvation through regeneration begins when I accept and confess Jesus Christ as my personal Savior and receive His forgiveness which was purchased by His death. There is no other way by which we can be saved (Acts 4: 12; Hebrews 9: 22; I Peter 1: 18, 19; Ephesians 1: 3-14; Romans 4: 1-9; Romans 5: 1-11; Galatians 3: 22; Romans 3: 19-23; Mt. 25: 34, 41, 46; Luke 16: 19-31; John 14: 1-3; Revelation 20: 11-15).
- **I believe** that Jesus sends the Holy Spirit to impart to us the fullness of the redemption He purchased on the cross. The Holy Spirit convicts, regenerates, heals, and effects our adoption us as sons and daughters of our God and King. The Holy Spirit gives us supernatural gifts which serve to edify the body of Christ and bear witness to the world. He helps us produce fruits of character that align with His indwelling presence. The Holy Spirit empowers us to live as God intended under His loving and gracious authority (John 14: 26; I Corinthians 3: 16; I Corinthians 12: 1-11; Luke 11: 13; John 7: 37-39, 14: 16, 17; Galatians 5: 22, 23; I Corinthians 14; Rom. 8:16; Acts 1: 4-8; 2: 1-18, 38-41; 4: 8; 10: 44-47; 11: 16; 16:

7-14; 19: 1-6; Matthew 8: 14-17; Isaiah 53: 5; I Peter 2: 24; James 5: 14-16; I Corinthians 12: 9; Mark 11: 23, 24).

## **CORE VALUES OF FMI**

- We value our unique calling as a body to carry and demonstrate the healing presence and power of the Lord, releasing the Gospel of the Kingdom to our families, our communities, and to the ends of the earth
- We value living expectantly and faithfully with a "last days" passion for the great end-time harvest and revival

- We value bringing God's presence into all aspects of day to day living in order to facilitate a Kingdom-centered transformation and reformation of culture
- We value Spirit-led, biblically infused preaching, teaching, prophecy, intercession, watching, fasting, and soaking
- We value the creative expression of God's presence and power through all forms of media: art, writing, music, film, photography, drama, dance, etc.
- We value relationship over religion, presence over perfection, receiving over striving

## CORE VALUES OF FRONTLINE TRAINING CENTER

- **I value HONOR** as God's chosen means for fostering healthy Kingdom relationships, both with Him and with others (1 Sam. 2:30). I choose to honor God, others, and the workings of the Holy Spirit in my life (1 Cor. 6:19-20). - **I value TRANSFORMATION** of heart and mind as my laid-down life is taken up by the Lord and filled with His Spirit (Rom. 12:2; 2 Cor. 3:18). I commit to being transformed in my spiritual understanding of what is possible for lovers of Jesus (Matt. 19:26; Eph. 1:18) who intentionally live in the power of the Spirit under an open heaven (Acts 10:38; Is. 64:1-2; Dt. 28:12; Mal 3:10). I choose to allow the Father to transform the borders of my faith, bringing Heaven to earth as my embraced lifestyle (Matt. 6:9-13).
